On, 12th & 13th September, 2021- A two-days training for capacity enhancement on Child Protection, Case Management & Referral system was conducted by child protection experts from Institute for Legal Research and Consultancy (ILRC) Mr. Chandrika Khatiwara and Mrs. Nina Maharjan. This training session was organized in joint partnership of CDS and World Vision, and in-coordination with Kirtipur Municipality. The training session was focused on regularization of effective tools that can be used in protecting the rights of children especially, focusing on mentally and physical disabled children. The members of the Child Rights Committee (CRC) participated in this traning session were from Balaji ward no-16, Kirtipur ward no and 1-10, and Kirtipur Municipality members.
