The main objective of training was, trainee will be able to obtain theoretical knowledge and perform First Aid in a proper and systematic manner. Trainee was more confident on providing basic life support and first aid during immdiate and emergency situation.

Sakriya Team Participation

In relation to the Sakriya project, the Child Development Society (Sakriya Team) took part in a 5-day Organizational Assessment workshop organized by World Education Inc.

The session was attended by Child Development Society and three other partner NGO's (Backward Society Education, Mahila Atma Nirbharta Kendra, and Human Right Awareness Center). The assessment's first three days were primarily focused on four main domains (organizational management, understanding of child labor and mechanisms, identification and documentation of child labor, and capacity to implement initiatives to address child labor and forced labor), while the fourth and fifth days were primarily focused on reviewing and providing feedback on the organization's five-year child labor strategy.

Day Care Program



Following the Covid-19 epidemic, our child day care service reopened on the 1st of Mangshir (17th Nov). Our day care now cares for 36 children ranging in age from 18 months to four years and operates from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. six days a week (Sunday-Friday). CDS provides a child-friendly environment in which they can grow physically and mentally. We are also concentrating on providing the best possible care for children and enhancing their rights in order to prepare them for school.



Emergency Health Support



Under the sponsorship project, 17,000 NRS was supported as emergency health support in November to operate on an unexpected growth of bone in an RC's left leg.
