Regarding SEEP (Self Employment Education Program, CDS has been supporting empower mothers from the most vulnerable and marginalized communities in Nepal. Through this project, CDS has been helping them for uplifting the economic Condition by making them self capable and self reliant.

CDS has been conducting SEEP project where about 40 mothers are enrolled. Two group with 20 participants in each group daily learn about the financial literacy and more educational things which help them to understand them-self and realize their capacity for being economic Stable.

Recently, Ms. Ainsley Roscrow (From Australia) had supported 500 AUD (Nrs about 42,000) for helping the women of the project. Financial support and literacy provided to them have inspired them for starting business at their own level.
